## **CITY OF MEMPHIS 2024 TRASH & RECYCLING SCHEDULE**

**You MUST have all materials  
at the curb BEFORE 7 a.m.**

### **COLLECTION INFORMATION**

**TRASH PICK UP IS PROVIDED WEEKLY.** If a holiday falls on or before your scheduled day, pickup will be one (1) day later than normal. If a holiday falls on a weekend, your scheduled pick up day will NOT change. **OBSERVED HOLIDAYS ARE:** New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.

**ALL TRASH MUST BE BAGGED IN A TRASH BAG AND SET AT THE CURB BY 7:00 a.m.** on the scheduled day of pick up. All materials in containers **MUST be bagged in a trash bag.** Containers should not weigh more than fifty (50) pounds each. For those with special pick up needs, contact the City of Memphis.

**UNACCEPTABLE MATERIALS:** Tires, concrete, fencing, any contractor or construction generated materials, free liquids (paints, pesticides, etc), car parts, appliances containing Freon, fluorescent bulbs (in excess of seven per household), and car batteries.

**RECYCLING: YOU DO NOT NEED TO SORT RECYCLABLE ITEMS! NO PLASTIC BAGS ARE ACCEPTED!  
RECYCLING BINS ARE AVAILABLE AT CITY HALL.**

**RECYCLABLE MATERIALS INCLUDE:**

Newspaper, phone books, junk mail, magazines, & glossy newspaper inserts. May be placed in brown paper sack or bundled and tied with string.

Clean corrugated cardboard should be bundled and tied in 2 foot squares, not exceeding a thickness of 1 foot.

Plastics 1-7 should be rinsed clean. NO motor oil, anti-freeze or cooking oil containers please.

Clean tin and aluminum cans. May be flattened to conserve space in your container.

Clear, brown and green empty glass. The glass should be rinsed out.
